ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)

This is where friends and family attend a service for their loved one and attend the burial/cremation.

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements for the funeral service. This includes liaising with the Coroner, Minister, Cemetery, Crematorium, etc.	£890.00
Collecting and transporting your loved one from their place of death into our care (within a 15 mile radius).	£200.00
Care of your loved one before the funeral in a private viewing room at our funeral home	£195.00
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium, (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle. (Normal weekday)	£290.00
Viewing of your loved one for family and friends, by appointment with us (where viewing is requested by you).	Price on request
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from an oak veneer. (Standard width and depth)	£420.00

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself (where the Funeral Director is not involved).

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee. ¹ In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:	Starting from: Churchyard: £300.00 ANBC Council Cemetery resident rate: First opening: £280.00 Second and subsequent opens: £170.00 ANBC Council resident New Plot: £300.00
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	
For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee. ² In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is:	£668.00

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
